Comenius project: 'LOL-Lively OutdoorLearning'- Report of the meeting in Haramsoy- Norway-15th/19th October 2013

Tuesday 15th October

Guests arrived in Haramsoy at different times. Headmaster and colleagues of Haramsoy skule went to the airport in Alesund and took them to the lighthouse of Haramsoy island where the partners from the different country stayed during the days of the meeting.

Wednesday 16th October

First day in Haramsoy skule. Headmaster and colleagues took all the guests from the lighthouse to the school and they had the first workshop. The headmaster presented himself and the school to the partners and each of them presented himself and his school too. Each partner showed a video or power point presentation of their schools in Estonia, Iceland, Italy, Poland, Spain. Partner from Turkey didn't participate to the meeting for some difficulties about the organization of his school. First they read the first outcomes in D4 section of the application and discussed and agree about the organization of the work:

***How to involve students and let them communicate.** It will be possible to send mails and agree appointments for video conferences on skype; they can send traditional mail; they 'll communicate through eTwinning exchanging ideas, work results and evaluating questionnaires.

*Deciding about each partner task during the project. Norway is the coordinator of the project, Estonia will prepare newsletters of the project to be shared on e Twinning. Iceland will be responsible of eTwinning site. Italy will write the report of every meeting and pass on information from project meetings to partner schools. Poland will prepare a logo of the project considering ideas from students of a brand to be given to it. Spain will refer to the communication and involvement and evaluation of the students through questionnaires or other. Turkey will be responsible of collecting and editing and publishing the final catalogue of the outdoor activities and instructions provided by the partner schools at the end of the project.

* About outcomes2: eTwinning site established, partners decide to send work on eTwinning and share a common diary, aside from own diary. Iceland will be responsible of receiving works and organize the twin space.

Students of 9th grade of Haramsoy skule prepared lunch cooking it outdoor in the traditional Viking way under the ground as a sample of outdoor crosscurricular activity to show to the guests.

Thursday 17th October

- Several outdoor activities were showed to guests by students of different grades. Working in groups is very important: there's a leader that is responsible of the group during a school year and of each member of it about behavior, involvement and participation to the work.

Students learn actively outdoor of math, science and other subjects and learn to interact among them.

-Guests visited the Lutheran church in Haramsoy.

-They had lunch at school.

-Guests were involved in a team competition with students. Each guest participated with a group to different races inside a wide room, outside of the school buildings, where different outdoor activities take place when it's impossible outdoor, depending on the weather.

-Visit to Rolls Royce factory that cooperate with the school involving and guiding students to learn to set up equipment and work on computing programs for boats automatic control systems.

Engineers and apprentices go to the school and teach and guide students in practical lessons. It is a very important cooperation for the school and the community that give the students an outlook to their future in the work world.

Friday 18th October

Guests visited primary school classes and were informed about methodology and organization of them. Working in group with a leader starts since the very first levels and he's an older guide in the group that is responsible of his friends.

Italian partners were interviewed by two students that will write an article on the school newspaper.

Guests visited laboratory where a practical lesson with cooperation of a Rolls Royce engineer and apprentices was carrying out as sample.

Lunch of all the partners at school.

Students danced traditional dances in the school hall to show them to the guests as sample of the kind of lessons in their school.

Project meeting of all the partners to constitute the eTwinning group together registering on line. Icelandic colleagues, guided the others during the registration .Partners discussed and agreed about sharing works on eTwinning and collect them to arrange a common diary of the project, aside from the individual diary that each partner can choose and decide how to organize it.
